- **1 -1.5h homework a week: Essay practice & Carousel recall**



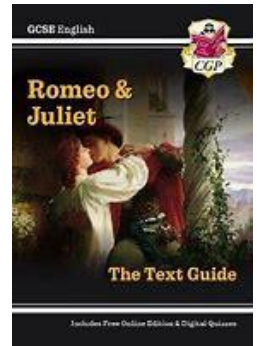
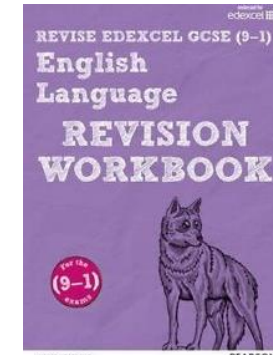
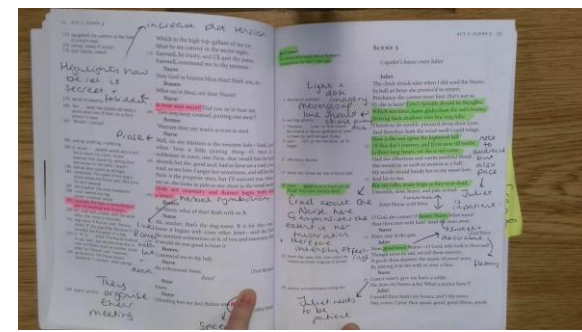
