THE CURRICULUM

We focus on the core subjects of English, mathematics and science to prepare every student for life beyond school, whether at university, in training or in employment.

In Year 7 all students study English, mathematics, sciences, French, classics and Latin, religious studies, technology, history, geography, physical education, art, drama and music.

In Key Stage 4, our students perform exceptionally well with GCSE results placing the school within the top 20% nationally for progress and the top 10% for English and Humanities.

TEACHING

SIXTH FORM

Our Sixth Form opened in September 2018, enabling our students to build on their excellent GCSE results.

The Sixth Form offers a wide range of courses and outstanding pastoral care. Sixth formers play a key role in the life of the school, modelling academic study and high levels of personal conduct for younger students.

Our students then progress to a range of career choices, including some to Russell Group universities including Oxford and Cambridge, and into competitive subjects such as Medicine, Science, Mathematics and Law



OUR FUTURE

From summer 2025, STA will have a building to reflect our ambitions, including:

- eight science laboratories
- six technology rooms
- specialist computer science facilities
- art studio
- drama studio
- music workshop
- a roof-top Multi Use Games Area (MUGA)
- 300-seat auditorium
- teaching rooms fully equipped with the latest technologies available to support learning

In addition, we will have a large Sports Hall and studio space for the wide range of sports we offer in our curriculum and during extra-curricular periods.

We will also have a state of the art, all-weather, 5G sports pitch, for use both in lessons and after school sports fixtures.



Outside school hours, our vision is to make much of the school available for community use.
