

# Message from Headteacher

It's been wonderful to welcome everybody back and in particular to meet our new Year 7s!

We have had a lot of last-minute enquiries about joining the school, which is very encouraging. It might have something to do with our record GCSE grades — Year 11 achieved almost half a grade of 'value added' per GCSE subject, which is especially impressive in a year where nationally, marking was much tougher, as marking reverted to 2019 levels. It has been excellent, too, to welcome back so many of a talented Year 11s to our Sixth Form.



I was delighted, too, to welcome numerous students via our New Brunswick Park Road entry point, which will be open to all students in Building 5 on a given day from 8.00am in the morning until 8.25am and then in the afternoon from 3.00 - 3.20pm. You can see the steel frame of the new Sports Hall rapidly taking shape along Brunswick Park Road, opposite the entrance to the New Southgate Cemetery.

We started the Year with an assembly on marginal gains and how establishing winning habits inside and outside of the classroom was the key to long-term success. Everything that you as a parent can do to support your child with regular mealtime and bedtimes and encouragement to polish off a substantial chunk of homework with an hour of returning home will boost your child's chances of success. We talked, too, about how, with God's grace, we can all work on being the person that God wants us to be and achieving our full potential.

So that we can prepare for our **Open Evening Event**, the school will close at 12.35pm on Tuesday 19 September 2023. Students in receipt of free school meals can collect these from the school canteen at that time. This will allow staff to prepare classrooms and displays for the evening.

Also, please note that on Wednesday 20 September 2023, students will have a later start to the school day so that staff can ensure that classrooms are ready for lessons on that day. Students must be in school at 10.35am where they will be registered in tutor time.


## The Nativity of the Holy Theotokos

# Site Update – Drop-off and Pick-up

You will have seen the exciting developments on the building of our new school over the summer. Further to the letter that went to parents earlier this week, we are pleased to inform you that there will be pedestrian access for students via Brunswick Road. Our construction



company (B&K) has created a pathway from the Brunswick Road to Building 5, which will aid access to students who live on the Brunswick Road side of the school for the days that they are timetabled in Building 5.

Please note the following regarding the use of this entrance:

- It is exclusively for students, and parents must drop-off at the start of the pathway.
- Parents who have appointments at the school must enter via Oakleigh Road so that they can enter through the visitors' entrance and sign in at reception.
- Entrance to the pathway will be open from 8.00am to 8.25am and from 3.00pm to 3.25pm. These times will be strictly adhered to.
- Students who are timetabled in Building 4
  must enter the North London Business Park
  through the Oakleigh Road entrance.

All other arrangements for dropping off students by car will continue. Therefore, if you wish to drop your child off at school, please access the North London Business Park via Oakleigh Road, continuing around the multi-storey car park and dropping off in the bays in front of the multi-storey car park. If you are collecting students at the end of the day, you may park in white bays on the ground floor of the car park, but please do not arrive before 2.45pm and ensure you leave before 3.20pm.

We will review the usage of this entrance in the opening weeks of the school term. If you have any questions or suggestions regarding the changes mentioned above, please contact the school through the usual channels.
